**COURT ORDERS FOR AN EXTENSION OF THE TIME PERIODS UNDER
S 239AT AND S 239Y OF THE COMPANIES ACT 1993 (WITHOUT NOTICE)**

1. The without notice originating application made by **COLIN THOMAS MCCLOY** and **DAVID JOHN BRIDGMAN** on 10 June 2014 was determined by the Honourable *Asher* on the *17th* day of June 2014.
2. The determination was made without a hearing.
3. The following orders were made:
 - (a) the applicants are granted leave to commence this proceeding without notice;
 - (b) the period defined in section 239AT(2) of the Companies Act 1993 ("**Act**") be extended by 61 days to 1 September 2014, under section 239AT(3) of the Act;
 - (c) the period defined in section 239Y(3) of the Act be extended by 82 days to 1 September 2014, under section 239Y(4) of the Act;
 - (d) within seven days of the date of these Orders, notice of these Orders is to be:
 - (i) made available on PricewaterhouseCoopers' website:

 - (ii) advertised once in *The New Zealand Herald*, *The Dominion*, *The Press* and *the Otago Daily Times*;
 - (e) leave to apply is granted to any person who can demonstrate a sufficient interest to modify or discharge either the above orders upon appropriate notice being given to the applicants; and
 - (f) the applicants' solicitor/client costs of this application will be an expense incurred by the applicants in carrying out their duties as administrators of the Company.
